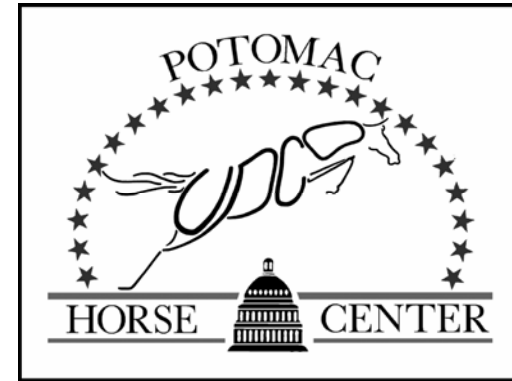


Rules

- Rider's age is determined as of December 1, 2007.
- Casual riding attire is acceptable, except in equitation classes where proper attire is required. Absolutely no jeans in classes.
- Controlled schooling in designated areas only from 7:30 a.m. until 8:15 am and also following the Horse Pleasure Division.
- Any person mounted on a horse or pony is required to wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet with the chin strap properly attached, proper footwear for riding and absolutely no sneakers.
- All horses and ponies must have a current (within 12 months) negative Coggins (EIA) test.
- All classes are payable by cash or check only with a \$25.00 fee for checks returned NSF.
- The judge's decision is final in all classes.
- NO DOGS! No Exceptions.
- Ribbons 1st - 6th in all classes, Champion and Reserve ribbons in all divisions. Medal classes are awarded 1st - 8th place ribbons. *Anyone* awarded points in the 2008 Medal classes is eligible for the finals on November 2!
- Riders schooling horses in designated areas MUST be wearing a number.

Classes and Divisions

Lead Line Equitation Class: Open to riders 7 years of age and under, riding horses or ponies. Judged on position, hands and seat. Entries may cross enter into the Mini Stirrup Walk class only.

Mini Stirrup Equitation Division: Open to riders 11 years of age and younger, riding horses or ponies. Judged on position, hands, seat and control of mount. Entries may not cross enter into any other division at the same show.

Short Stirrup Equitation Division: Open to riders 10 years of age and under, riding horses or ponies. Judged on position, hands, seat and control of mount. Entries may cross enter into Horse or Pony Pleasure and Beginner Hunter.

Young Rider Equitation Division: Open to riders 11 to 17 years of age riding horses and ponies. Judged on position, hands, seat and control of mount. Fences 2'. Entries may cross enter only into Horse or Pony Pleasure and Beginner Hunter only.

Adult Equitation Division: Open to riders who have reached their 18th birthday, riding horses or ponies. Judged on position, hands, seat and control of mount. Entries may cross enter only into Horse or Pony Pleasure and Beginner Hunter.

Beginner Hunter Division: Open to riders eligible for Short Stirrup Equitation, Young Rider Equitation, and Adult Equitation only. Judged as a hunter class. Fences 2'. Entries may cross enter into Horse or Pony Pleasure Divisions only.

PHC/UPCO Beginner Equitation Medal: Open to riders who participate in one of the following divisions at the same show: Short Stirrup, Young Rider, Adult Equitation, and Beginner Hunter. Fences 2'. Judged on position, hands, seat and control of mount. Eight riders will be called back to work on the flat. Riders awarded points in 2008 are eligible to ride in the finals.

Pony Pleasure Division: Open to all junior and adult amateur riders on ponies. Judged on manners, way of going, soundness and suitability to be a pleasure mount.

Horse Pleasure Division: Open to all junior and adult amateur riders on horses. Judged the same as Pony Pleasure division with the same classes and the same rules.

Open Hunter Division: Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Fences class 2' or 2'6". Judged on manners, way of going, soundness and suitability. Two fence heights offered in each over-fences class (riders choice) 2' or 2'6".

Child/Adult Hunter Division: Combined unless entries warrant. Open to children and adults on horses only. Judged on manners, way of going, soundness and suitability.

PHC/UPCO Child/Adult Equitation Medal: Open to all junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Fences 2' for ponies, 2'6" for horses. Judged on position, hands, seat and control of mount. Riders awarded points in 2008 are eligible to ride in the finals. Eight riders will be called back to work on the flat.

Schooling Hunter Division: Open to riders on horses only. No combinations. Judged on manners, way of going, soundness and suitability. Two jump heights offered in each over fences class (riders choice) 2'9" or 3'.

Future Jumpers: Open to all horses and ponies. Fences 2'3" and 2'6". No combinations. Course may consist of any combination of brush, gate, oxer, coop, liverpool, panels or narrow jumps.

Training Jumpers: Open to all horses and ponies. Fences 2'9". Course may consist of any type of rails, brush, gate, oxer, coop, liverpool, panels, wishing well or narrow jumps. Table II, Sec. 2(b).

Gambler's Choice: Open to all. Fences 3'. Jumps are awarded a point value, rider designs and jumps course in the time allowed. Joker Fence offered.
